A. Authorizing the Issuance of Bonds – Vertical Cold Storage

Commissioner Terrebonne made a motion that the Board adopt a Resolution authorizing the issuance of Port KC's Taxable Revenue Bonds (Vertical Cold Storage – Real Property) in a maximum principal amount of \$119,000,000, the issuance of Port KC's Taxable Revenue Bonds (Vertical Cold Storage – Personal Property) in a maximum principal amount of \$21,500,000, and the execution of related documents.

Councilperson O'Neill seconded the motion.
